Watches, wedding rings, photos: When the Nazis imprisoned people in concentration camps, they confiscated all their personal belongings. The personal effects of around 2500 former concentration camp prisoners are still stored in the Arolsen Archives. The aim of the #StolenMemory campaign is to search for the victims' families in order to return the stolen mementoes to them. A network of volunteers from all over Europe help us in the search. Since 2016, we have found over 750 families all over the world. The archives hold the personal effects of eight people from Greece whose cases have yet to be solved.
